Mixed Media Circles By Rebekah Meier

Materials

- 12" x 12" canvas
- Fabric Elements[™] Tissue Papers
- Thin bodied acrylic paint (Dye-na-Flow)
- White and gold metallic craft paint
- Faber Castell® Gelatos®
- 2- 12" coffee filters
- paper napkins, paintable fabric, old book pages
- Gel medium
- 1/2" flat paintbrush
- Embellishments: such as buttons, paper flowers and lace
- Paper punch
- Compass
- Scissors
- Fabric adhesive that can be machine stitched
- Iron
- Sewing machine and thread to match

Instructions

- 1. Using the flat brush, apply thin even layer of gel medium onto one side of coffee filter.
- 2. Cut or tear pieces of fabric, paper napkins, and tissue papers onto gel medium side of filter. Let dry. Cover with parchment paper and press with hot iron.
- 3. Fold paper/fabric covered coffee filter in half. Go over crease with finger. Open and repeat in opposite direc-

tion. Mark a small dot where both crease lines intersect. Place point of compass onto small dot. Using compass, draw a 1 1/2", 3", 5", and one remaining 8" circle. Fold coffee filter in half and cut on traced lines, creating circle strips.

- 4. Audition strips onto remaining coffee filter. When happy with design, glue to secure circle strips in place.
- 5. Machine straight and zigzag stitch seams of circles and around perimeter of coffee filter.
- 6. Embellish completed circle with paint cap marks, buttons, and paper flowers.
- 7. Repeat all steps, creating four 2 1/2" circles.

Circle Collage Canvas

- 1. Using gel medium, apply a paper background onto 12" canvas. Let dry.
- 2. Center finished 12" circle onto center of fabric, and secure with gel medium.
- 3. Using Gelatos, apply color around the edge of canvas. If desired, adhere embellishments such as beads or buttons to the circle.
