

## **RESIN SKULL WALL ART**

### **MATERIALS:**

Two-part resin  
Plastic cup, stirrer  
Wax paper  
Piece of cardboard  
Cray Pas Oil Pastels  
Craft knife  
Skull die cut pattern  
Paper and embellishments  
Craft glue

### **INSTRUCITONS**

Follow the package directions and mix the two parts together in a cup. Fold the mixture until it is evenly mixed. Don't stir too hard.

Line the cardboard with wax paper and tape down.

Pour the resin in the center of the cardboard and use the stirrer to spread it evenly.

Use your craft knife to shave off pieces of the oil pastels and sprinkle them on the wet resin.

Let cure overnight.

The next you'll have a thin sheet of resin! Cut a piece to run through a cutter to get the skull shape, or whatever desired shape you want.

Use it to affix to a canvas and embellish with papers and embellishments.
