



EVERY DAY DOODLING

SUPPLIES

- Journal
- Sakura Pigma Micron PN pens
- Balzer Designs "Folkart Moths" stencil from The Crafter's Workshop in 12x12
- Painter's tape
- Sakura Koi Brush Marker

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Tape the stencil to your notebook so that the moth is where you want it on the page. Use painter's tape so that it's easy to remove.
2. Trace the stencil with a Sakura Pigma Micron PN pen.
3. Add doodles to the outside areas of the design. Use simple shapes like lines, dashes, and circles.
4. Add the "title" of your journaling to the body of the moth. If it doesn't fill the whole body, add doodling at the bottom.
5. Add your journaling to the large inside



sections of the moth's wings. Try to use one color for the top set of wings and a different color for the bottom set of wings.

6. Add a drop shadow to the text and each section of the moth with a Sakura Koi Brush Marker.
