HOW TO MAKE ONE OF YOUR OWN

1. Use gel medium to adhere painty text or book paper to a small canvas panel

- 2. Sand the edges of the panel removing any excess paper and gel medium
- 3. Cut an inspirational word out of patterned scrapbook paper using the Brother® Scan N Cut
- 4. Adhere cut word to the canvas using gel medium
- 5. Splatter watercolor onto the canvas panel and let dry
- 6. Add marks with pens and pencils
- 7. Punch holes along the bottom edge of the panel (you will need a heavy duty punch)
- 8. Cut 8"pieces of ribbon and slip knot a piece through each hole using tweezers or darning needle to help feed the ribbon through the holes
- 9. Punch a hole at each of the top two corners of the panel
- 10.Cut a 12" piece of ribbon and slip knot each end into a hole at the top of the panel creating a hangar

SUPPLIES NEEDED

3 x 3 canvas panel
book or text paper
gel medium
watercolors
paintbrush
3 yards of ribbon
heavy duty hole punch
sandpaper
favorite mark making tools
tweezers or darning needle
patterned scrapbook paper
