



LAYERING & MASKING

SUPPLIES

- Polypropylene Paper
- Graftix Liquid Frisket
- Graftix Incredible Nib
- Watercolor
- Jar of Clean Water
- Large Paintbrush
- Graftix Liquid Frisket Remover
- Graftix Matte Frisket Film
- Scissors
- Stamps – rubber or hand carved
- Permanent Stamping Ink
- Paint Markers

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw some random designs and shapes onto the polypropylene paper using the Incredible Nib and Graftix Liquid Frisket. Let dry.
2. Once the the Frisket is dry, add some stamped images.



3. Cover the paper with various colors of watercolor. Let dry.
4. Once the painted paper is dry, add some doodles with paint markers and more stamping, if you wish.
5. Draw some simple leaf shapes onto the paper side of the Graftix Matte Frisket Film. Cut them out with a pair of scissors.
6. Apply the Frisket Film leaves to the painted surface. Adhere them well.
7. Paint over the entire surface with watercolor. Let dry.
8. Once the paper is dry, add stamping and doodling.
9. Ensure that the surface of the paper is totally dry then remove the Frisket Film.
10. Use the Graftix Liquid Frisket Remover to remove the dried Liquid Frisket.
