Leather Tassel Necklace Set By Candie Cooper

Materials:

Beading wire

Crimp tubes

Gauged wire

Clasp

End cap

Ring findings

Assorted beads, charms, and gemstones

Leather cord

Flat leather

Glue (E6000)

Tools:

Scissors

Wire cutters

Crimping pliers

2 pairs of chain- or flat-nose pliers

Sizzix Jewelry Cutting Tool

Sizzix Movers and Shapers Die

- 1. To form the leather cord necklace: String one end of the leather cord through one ring finding and fold over, leaving about 1/2" tail. Use wire to wrap around the cord ends. Repeat on the free end of the cord.
- 2. Use the beading wire to string 1 crimp tube and the first ring finding from Step 1. Pass back through the crimp tube and crimp. String beads and charms as desired. String 1 crimp tube and the remaining ring; pass back through the crimp tube and crimp.
- 3. To form the leather tassel necklace: Place the platform, die, leather, and cutting pad onto the Sizzix machine and run it through the machine. This forms the fringe for the tassel.
- 4. Place a few drops of glue into the end cap. Roll the leather fringe and firmly press one end into the end cap. Let dry.
- 5. Use the beading wire to string 1 crimp tube and one half of the clasp. Pass back through the crimp tube and crimp.
- 6. String beads and charms in desired order for half of the necklace. Attach the end cap to the connector using a jump ring, then string the connector onto the beading wire. Continue stringing beads and charms for the second half of the necklace.
- 7. Repeat Step 5.
