Art Paper Abstract Circles by: Rebekah Meier

This project will demonstrate techniques for designing Adhesive Art Papers, and then using them to create an abstract piece of art. The techniques will include applying Transfer Foils, mono printing with a stencil, cutting circles with the Brother International Corporation ScanNCut, and surface design.

**Materials** 

- Rebekah Meier Designs Mixed Media Adhesive Art Paper Sheets by Therm O Web
- Rebekah Meier Designs Mixed Media Transfer Foils by Therm O Web
- Rebekah Meier Designs Mixed Media Medium by Therm O Web
- Rebekah Meier stencils from The Crafter's Workshop #705S Star and Flower 12"x12"
- ScanNCut machine by Brother International Corporation
- ScanNCut Standard Mat by Brother International
- ScaNCut Standard Blade Holder Brother International
- Canvas (size determined by cut circle)
- Gelpress printing plate
- Brayer
- Ruler
- Rubber stamps and archival ink
- Paint, assorted colors
- Black marker

Instructions

- 1. Set up ScanNCut to cut one 7-9" circle from Mixed Media Art Paper.
- 2. Using stencil Star and Flower (#705S), and Quinacridone Magenta paint or ink, stencil design onto cut Art Paper circle.
- 3. Color some of the white areas of circle with pigment crayons. Wet pigment with a little water and move around within the design.
- 4. Remove release paper from the back of the decorated Art Paper. Stick circle onto the canvas.
- 5. Cut and tear strips of other decorated Mixed Media Art Papers and stick onto the circle, creating an abstract design.
