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## HOW TO MAKE ONE OF YOUR OWN

- Spritz a shallow pan with water followed by a few sprays of your favorite colored spray inks.
- 2. Next, mist your dye catcher sheets with water and place in the pan to absorb the dye.
- 3. Lift sheet out and hang or lay flat to dry.
- 4. Repeat the above steps with three more sheets.
- 5. Once all sheets are dry, doodle on them with a metallic marker.
- 6. Pin all four sheets right sides together and stitch up the sides to create one long rectangle.
- 7. Fold short end up 3/4 of the way, right sides together, and stitch up the two folded short sides.
- 8. Turn pouch right side out and fold corners of flap in and down to form two triangles. Stitch in place.
- 9. Add a small piece of sticky back velcro to the inside bottom of flap & matching point on front side of pouch.
- 10. Glue an embellishment to front flap.
