Van Gogh's Brushstrokes: Loose Florals

Materials needed:

Watercolor paper

Paper trimmer

Scissors

Adhesive, tape runner or glue stick

Ranger Foam Tape

Piece of dictionary paper

Black cardstock

Dina Wakley Media Acrylic Paint: Lemon, Cheddar, White, Fuchsia, Night, Turquoise, Lime, Evergreen,

Umber

Dina Wakley Media Stamps: Just What to Say

Acrylic block

Orange Seam Binding Ribbon

Ranger Archival Ink Pad, Jet Black

Instructions:

- 1. Paint a piece of watercolor paper Fuchsia (all over the paper). Let dry.
- 2. Start flowers by painting petals with Lemon paint.
- 3. Add a few petals with Cheddar.
- 4. Add a few with Umber
- 5. Add a few with White.
- 6. Paint Night paint in the center of the flowers.
- 7. Add leaves with Lime and Evergreen paint.
- 8. Paint around the flowers, covering up most but not all of the background. Let dry.
- 9. Cut the flower paper into desired size for cards. I did 3.25"x5" panels.
- 10. Tie ribbon around the card.
- 11. Mount the card front on dictionary paper and cut so there is a small border.
- 12. Mount on black cards (8.5"x4.25", folded in half).
- 13. Stamp your sentiments, cut them out, and mount them on colorful paper, if desired.
- 14. Add your sentiment to the card front with foam tape.
