Pattern Resist with Color wash! Watercolor Washes over Liquid Frisket. By Janet Takahashi

## **SUPPLIES & TOOLS:**

- -Koi WaterColors Pocket Field Sketch Box
- -Koi Coloring Brush Pens
- -Gelly Roll pens for embellisments
- -Liquid Frisket; Grafix Incredible White Mask
- -Grafix Liquid Frisket Remover
- -Grafix The Incredible Nib
- -Small 6-well palette (for liquid frisket)
- -Paintbrush with synthethic hair (for liquid frisket)
- -Paintbrushes, flat and pointed & Koi Water brush
- -bar soap (for cleaning brush used for resist)
- -Water container
- -Paper towels
- -Ruler
- -Pencil/Eraser
- -Masking tape
- -Light Table optional, to be used with a grid or design to be traced
- -small trash container to collect removed frisket

## Instructions:

- 1. Tape area of pattern with masking tape
- 2. Apply Liquid Frisket:
  - Pour into a smaller well palette
  - Remove dried frisket from well with wooden skewer
  - Cover frisket while working
  - Can add a cobalt blue colorant
  - Apply frisket
- 3. Ways to apply watercolor:
  - Pointed brush, spot areas
  - Wash area with different colors
  - flat brush, larger areas (use more water in the palette)
  - pouring paint and flicking in more color
- 4. Remove Frisket using crepe rubber frisket remover
- 5. Intensify color, adding additional color wth Koi coloring brush pens
- 6. Embellish with additional gel pens
- 7. Remove final taped border
