

## **Inspired by post-impressionist art**

Supplies Needed: watercolor paper, cardstock, ScanNCut, watercolor or color mediums, buttons and sequins, liquid adhesive, glitter glue, black pen

Instructions:

1. Using watercolors, markers, and other mediums draw your design.
2. Once dry, place on a mat and insert into ScanNCut. Scan the mat (for placement), select your design, and cut it out.
3. Place onto folded card, then outline with embellishments to complete.
