

Cat Kerr - When Pigs Fly

Material List

1. Artist Papers found in Somerset Studio Publications
2. Wood Embroidery Hoop
3. Tacky Glue
4. Marabu Art Crayons (Cherry, Sunshine Yellow, Turquoise, Orange)
5. Water Brush
6. Make up sponge
7. Scissors
8. Black and White Media Fluid
9. Wood Spacer
10. Flying Pig Wood Cut outs
11. Marabu Gold Art Spray
12. Stickles Glitter Glue
13. Black String
14. Sequin
15. Wire/Wire cutter

Step by Step

1. Pick out an artist paper design
2. Add yellow and Turquoise Art Crayon to the embroidery hoop. Spread the color around with your finger, a cosmetic sponge or water brush.
3. Glue the embroidery hoop to the artist paper.(Be sure to have the metal piece on the top so that you can later use that to hang your piece) When dry, trim the excess paper with scissors and add a turquoise shadow to the inside of the hoop wall using the water pen.
4. Add splatters of black and white media fluid.
5. Glue a spacer to the spot that you are going to place your wood shape design.
6. Add a gradient color to the pig by using Sunshine Yellow, Orange and Cherry to the pig. Move the color by using your finger, a cosmetic sponge or water brush.
7. Add splatters of Gold Art Spray.
8. Add splatters of Black and White Media Fluid.
9. Finish the pig by adding a text sticker and Glitter Stickles around the border of the design.
10. Glue on some black thread, the wood shape and sequin to the inside of the embroidery hoop.
11. Add some wire to the metal piece for hanging.
