

Sandra Evertson - Faux Verdigris box



Materials:

R&A matte resin craft blanks

Wood box

Tacky glue/hot glue/Goop

Metal hinge closure

Upholstery tacks

Vintage velvet scraps

Acrylic paint in dark turquoise, light turquoise, light green, sage green, lime green, copper, chalk powder in dark brown/grey or old makeup eye shadow)

Small hammer

Craft mat

Palette

Brushes

Scissors

Pencil

Make up sponges

Water cup

Paper towels

Hot air gun

broken jewelry, beads, vintage buttons, found trinkets, stones, metal stampings, etc.

Steps

1. Measure, cut and glue velvet to interior of box with tacky glue.
2. Hot glue resin blanks on top of box.
3. Put hinge closure on box with hammer.
4. Paint first coat of light turquoise paint on box. Paint faux verdigris finish on entire box.
5. Instant "age" with chalk powders/old make up.
6. Apply upholstery tacks with hammer.
7. Decorate with broken jewelry, beads, vintage buttons, found trinkets, stones, metal stampings, etc.
