I love making my own journals using Joggles Disc Bound pages and discs, I only wish they came with a cover. So why not make my own using one of the Black Disc Bound Journal Pages and Black Aves Apoxie Sculpt.

### Step by Step:

1. Assemble a journal by using both White and Black Disc Bound pages and the plastic discs. (These journals come already assembled or you can buy the pages individually and include your own pages)
2. Mix up two equal parts of Aves Apoxie in Black
3. Spread it evenly on to a black journal page but do not cover the notches for the binding.
4. Press charms and bezel body on to the cover.
5. Add some metallic powder to the cover and then press assorted Creative Art Textures into the clay and let cure.
6. Paint cover with acrylic paint.
7. Add fiber scraps to the inside of bezel.
