

Cat Kerr - Practice Makes Progress

I always say that I wish I could draw faces. A fun way to practice is by using a magazine face as a starting point. Tracing it on to Matte Dura-lar helps me to not only practice making faces, but it also allows me to make these new faces completely unique and different!

Materials List:

- Magazine image of a face
- Matte Dura-lar by www.GrafixArts.com
- Faber Castell Goldfaber Colored Pencils <http://www.fabercastell.com/>
- Faber Castell Lettering Art Bold Pitt Artist Pens <http://www.fabercastell.com/>
- Faber Castell Black Fine Pitt Pens <http://www.fabercastell.com/>

Step by Step:

1. Use the magazine face as a guide and trace it using the matte Dura-lar and colored pencils.
2. Using the face that you drew as a guide add flowers with colored Pitt Pens and spread with finger or water brush. Add text.
3. Outline all the elements using a FC medium black Pitt Pen.
4. Finish your design with FC colored Pencils.
