

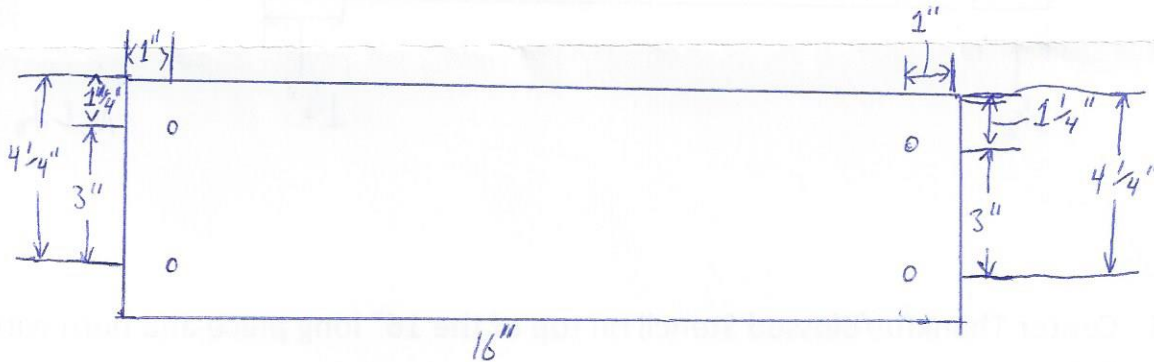
# Thankful Tray Instructions

**Tools Required:** Saw, Sandpaper (150 grit), Drill,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " Drill Bit, Philips Screwdriver, Butane Torch, Stencils (Thankful/Blessed)

**Materials Required:**

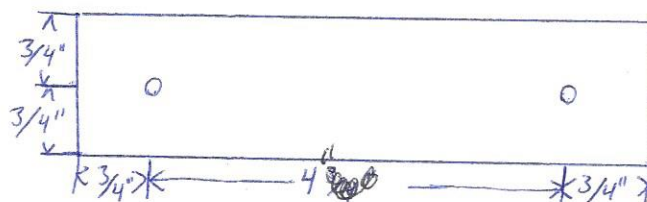
- 1" x 6" Board Stock
- Spray Lacquer
- (1-1/4" Wood Screw) x4
- (3" Metal Handle) x2

1. Using a saw cut one piece of board stock 16" long, and cut two pieces 1-1/2" long
2. Drill four holes in the 16" long piece

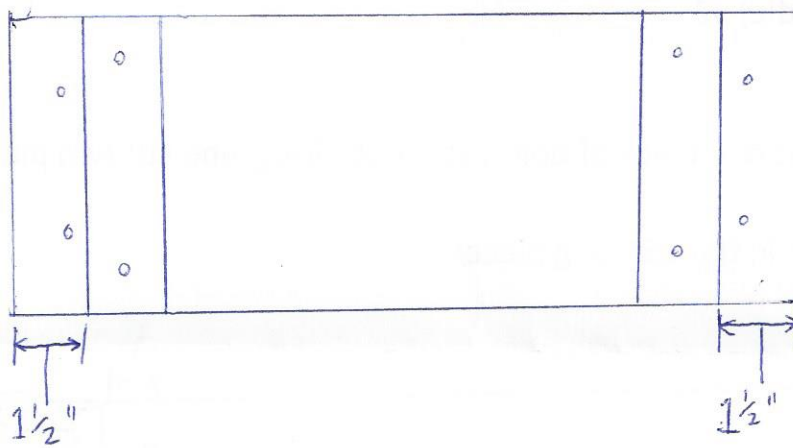
3. Drill two holes in each of the 1-1/2" long piece

- Screw each 1-1/2" long piece 1-1/2" from each end of the 16" board

- Center Thankful/Blessed Stencil on top of the 16" long piece and burn with Butane Torch
  - Use screwdriver to hold down stencil while burning
- Spray piece with lacquer to seal burnt text
- Once the lacquer is dry attach 3" metal handles
