US Travel Map By Kristin Gambaccini

Supplies

- *24x36 paper United States map & corkboard piece
- *Spray Adhesive
- *Pine wood (1" x 3/4") trim pieces for 4'x2' frame
- *Sanding block
- *Wood stain (Pine) & 2 rags
- *Clear Acrylic Sealer
- *Reciprocating Saw
- *Nail/Brad Gun & 5/8 Brad Nails
- *50" length of Twine
- *Wood push pins
- *1" wood craft circles
- *Wood Burner & numbers
- *Hot Glue
- *Power Drill & 3/16" drill bit



Instructions

- 1. Glue map to corkboard piece using spray adhesive
- 2. Measure, cut & stain wood trim pieces for frame. Spray dried pieces with clear acrylic sealer.
- 3. Attach frame to corkboard map using brad nailers
- 4. Drill (2) 3/16" holes approx. 1/2" down from top on both sides of frame
- 5. Run a piece of twine through the holes & knot in front for hanging
- 6. Using wood burner & numbers, burn dates of travel onto 1" circles
- 7. Hot glue circles to tops of wood push pins
- 8. Press dated push pins into Map
